This Third Edition provides a solid and well-balanced introduction to probability theory and mathematical statistics. The book is divided into three parts: Chapters 1-6 form the core of probability fundamentals and foundations; Chapters 7-11 cover statistics inference; and the remaining chapters focus on special topics. For course sequences that separate probability and mathematics statistics, the first part of the book can be used for a course in probability theory, followed by a course in mathematical statistics based on the second part, and possibly, one or more chapters on special topics. The book contains over 550 problems, 350 worked-out examples, and 200 side notes for reader reference. Numerous figures have been added to illustrate examples and proofs, and answers to select problems are now included. Many parts of the book have undergone substantial rewriting, and the book has also been reorganized. Chapters 6 and 7 have been interchanged to emphasize the role of asymptotics in statistics, and the new Chapter 7 contains all

of the needed basic material on asymptotics. Chapter 6 also includes new material on resampling, specifically bootstrap. The new Further Results chapter includes some estimation procedures such as M-estimates and bootstrapping. A new chapter on regression analysis has also been added and contains sections on linear regression, multiple regression, subset regression, logistic regression, and Poisson regression.
